Château Malbat

In the heart of Entre-Deux-Mers, Château Malbat has been owned by the Rochet family since 1865 and is now in its 5th generation. Seventy acres of vines are grown on a unique limestone subsoil. Vine age averages approximately 30 years. Believe it or not, the family now produces just one wine - Château Malbat Rouge - from their 70 Ha.

Château Malbat Rouge

Site: From near the town of Le Réole, in Entre-Deux-Mers. **Grapes:** 70% Merlot, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc. **Vinification:** Vinified in temperature-controlled, stainless steel vats. **Elevage:** Settled and aged in stainless steel and cement vats before being bottled; this also is "pure wine" made without any influence of oak. **Notes:** Juicy, bright, sweet fruit - this wine is pure yum. Price/quality ratio is quite astounding.

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
